

Double Vowel Syllables

- When two vowels are together that make one sound, they form a **double vowel syllable**

/oi/ sound: **-oi** and **-oy** (the y is acting as a vowel)

-oi vowel team- goes in the middle or beginning of a syllable

-oy vowel team- goes at the end of a syllable

Marking “D” syllables:

- Circle the vowel team
- swoop the syllable with a “d” underneath
