## Bonus Letters and Glued Sounds

## **Bonus letters:** ff, ll, ss, and sometimes zz

• Words get a bonus *f*, *l*, *or s and sometimes z* if the letter immediately follows a short vowel.

(Example: miss, chill, buff)

\*\*Bonus **ll** changes the short **a** sound to /**ol**/.

(Example: all – ball)

<u>Marking bonus letters:</u> Bonus letters are marked by putting a star next to the bonus letter.



## **Glued Sounds**

These keep their individual sounds, but are "glued" together all, am, an, ank, ing, ink, ong, onk, ung, unk

Marking glued sounds: Glued sounds are marked by putting a box around the glued sound.
