

Closed Syllable Exceptions

- There are 5 exceptions to closed syllables
- They are closed syllable exceptions, taught as glued sounds
- They have 1 vowel followed by two or more consonants, but their vowel is **long**.

-ild, -ind, -old, -olt, -ost

Marking:

- Because these sounds are glued sounds, they are still marked with a box. However, because of the exception, the “c” under the syllable swoop is crossed out, and there is a macron marked above the long vowel sound.
